Dear Parent,

We are glad to inform you that we are organizing **Poem recitation and Dance competition** for the Kindergarten section (as informed earlier).

Poem recitation elimination round will be held on Tuesday (12-01-2021).

Dance competition elimination round will be held on Sunday (17-01-2021). (During class hours for physical schooling students.)

The details of competitions are as follows:

Class	Day and date	Competition	Theme / topic
KG1 & KG2	Elimination round (12/01/2021)	English poem recitation	Students to recite a short & appropriate English poem. Only poems will be considered, NOT rhymes, songs or action songs. Time limit – not exceeding 2 minutes.
KG1 & KG2	Elimination round (17/01/2021)	Dance competition	Cinematic/Classical/ Semiclassical/Folk categories Time limit – not exceeding 3 minutes. Note – Please ensure that the songs are age-appropriate and that they do not contain unpleasant lyrics. The songs can be of any language.





Please note:

- 1. Students to recite a poem with action, only poems will be considered, **NOT** rhymes, songs or action songs.
- 2. Students can perform the dance in Western/Cinematic/Classical/ Semi-classical/Folk categories.
 - Please ensure that the songs are age-appropriate and that they do not contain unpleasant lyrics. The songs can be of any language.
- 3. Time limit should not exceed what is mentioned under details.
- 4. If students are interested in participating, parents are requested to inform the respective class teachers on or before Thursday, 7th January. Please adhere to this date strictly.
- 5. Elimination round will be conducted on Tuesday 12 January 2021, for Poem recitation and on Sunday 17 January 2021, for Dance competition, 11:30 AM onwards.
- 6. The date of final round will be informed to the finalists by the respective class teacher, after the elimination round.
- 7. The same poem can be recited for the elimination round and the final round.
- 8. The same dance can be performed for the elimination round and the final round.
- 9. Students must recite the poem and perform the dance independently.
- 10. Judgement will be fair and based on the rubrics mentioned below.
- 11. Certificates will be awarded to the winners of both competitions.
- 12. Students will be judged on these following rubrics: -

Poem recitation:

Introduction, fluency, pronunciation, voice modulation and expression.

Dance competition:

Costume, expression, Performance & Choreography, Song & music, Overall performance
