This is to inform you that Abu Dhabi public health center has initiated to provide the comprehensive screening for **KG1**, **KG 2**. **Gr 1**, **5 and 9 students**. So please read the details carefully, fill the consent form and return it to the class teacher by 16-09-2024 .The cost of the screening process is **Dhs 200**/-.

If you are agreeing for the screening process of your ward, you have to send **AED 200** along with the duly filled consent form and a copy of your ward's Emirates ID in the sealed envelope that will be sent to you from school.

Directives for conducting School Screenings for Private and Charter school students in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi

As part of the continuous efforts of the Abu Dhabi Public Health Centre to provide the highest levels of health care and maintain the health of community members, especially the health of school students, we would like to recall and emphasize the procedures that must be followed to implement the school screening program for school students in Private and Charter schools in Abu Dhabi.

Therefore, all private and charter schools are encouraged to conduct the School Screening as outlined in the DOH Standard for School Screening Sep 2023 (DOH/STD/SSS/V2). The School Screening Program includes 2 screenings:

1. Comprehensive School Screening:

a. The Comprehensive school screening includes the following screenings and the grades/years mentioned below:

2. Annual Screening:

- a. Applicable all grades (Grade 1-12/Year 2-13)
- b. The annual school screening includes the following screenings.
 - i. Vital Signs
 - ii. Body Mass Index (z-score)
 - iii. Vision test
- c. The annual screening must be conducted by the school nursing staff and kept on student records: <u>Click Here</u>
