At EFIA, we believe every book is a portal to a new world just waiting to be explored. To celebrate the joy of reading, we are turning the entire school into a hub for World Book Day. From primary to senior levels, we invite all students to dive into a day of immersive activities and literary magic!

KG: Step Into a Story!

- ❖ Dress up as a favorite story character.
- ❖ Bring a small prop to support the presentation.
- ❖ Deliver a short introduction with simple lines.

Grade 1: Story Squad – 'Be the Star of Your Story'

- ❖ Select a storybook and dress as a favorite character.
- ❖ Speak a few lines about the chosen character.
- ❖ Explain personal reasons for liking that character.

Grade 2: Character Parade – 'From Book to Life'

- ❖ Introduce yourself while dressed as a favorite character.
- ❖ Speak 3–5 sentences about the character's role.
- ❖ Use a small prop to enhance the presentation.

Grade 3: Twist the Tale!

- ❖ Dress as a character and present their original story.
- ❖ Create a twist by changing the story's ending.
- ❖ Introduce a new character to alter the outcome.

Grade 4: Mission: Save the Magic Library

- ❖ Roleplay as 'Book Heroes' to save a magical library.
- ❖ Complete tasks like guessing clues and acting out parts.
- ❖ Collaborate on group stories and new book covers.

Grade 5: Book Cover Design

- ❖ Redesign a book cover using paper or digital tools.
- ❖ Choose specific colors and images to represent the book.
- ❖ Explain the creative reasoning behind the new design.

Grade 6: Character in a Bag

- ❖ Choose a character you admire and decorate a bag or box with the book's title, author, and an image of that character
- ❖ Include at least three character traits with supporting examples from the text and a significant quote by or about the character on the bag.
- ❖ Place 3–5 physical items inside the bag that symbolize the character, key story events, or major themes to be used during your one-minute in-class presentation.

Grade 7: Escape the Book

- ❖ Design a mini escape challenge based on a major conflict.
- ❖ Create 3–5 clues, such as riddles or secret codes.
- ❖ Present the final solution via a worksheet, poster or digital slides.

Grade 8: Literary Dinner Party

- ❖ Host a virtual party for three characters from different books.
- ❖ Draw visual scenes of the characters interacting together.
- ❖ Write dialogue snippets and suspenseful text for the event.

Grade 9: Book Review & Presentation

- ❖ Create a PowerPoint covering the summary, theme, and review.
- ❖ Describe a favorite character's traits and importance.
- ❖ Design a new book cover with a title and tagline.

Grade 10: Diary Entry

- ❖ Write a 150-word entry of a character's memorable day.
- ❖ Contrast public actions with private, internal emotions.
- ❖ Use an authentic character voice and sensory details.

Grade 11: The Critical Lens Challenge

- ❖ Analyse a chosen book through a specific perspective (e.g., historical, social, or ethical).
- ❖ Compare the protagonist's choices against modern societal values or a different literary era.
- ❖ Defend a "critical thesis" about the book's relevance in a 2-minute persuasive pitch.

Grade 12: Reading Opens Minds

- ❖ Write a 100–150 word paragraph on the central theme.
- ❖ Analyse main events and key character motivations.
- ❖ Reflect on an important lesson learned from the book.
