Emirates Future International Academy is planning to conduct Islamic competitions for the students from Grades VI to XII. The elimination round for the competitions will be conducted during the Islamic periods. Final competitions will be held on 13th & 14th May 2026.

Instructions for the competitions:

1. The competition will be conducted face to face.
2. While presenting boys must wear a prayer cap and girls must wear white scarf.
3. Medals and certificates will be given to the winners.
4. For each category 3 winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd) will be selected by the Judges.
5. Judgment will be done by the panel of eminent judges.
6. Judges' decision will be final.

Inters 6 – 8	2 min	Surah Maryam (64-65 verses)	Judgment will be done category wise for boys and girls separately. Judgment will be done based on the following criteria: Fluency, Ibtida, Tajweed, melodiousness & art of recitation.
Seniors (9 to 12)	2 min	Surah Taha (1-10 verses)	

Calligraphy:

Category : Sub Seniors (6 to 8)	Duration	Remarks
Topic : (Will be given on spot)	20 min	Each participant should write a given short Islamic phrase within the allotted time. Participants may include simple decorative designs, but clarity of the text must be the primary focus. The artwork should reflect both accuracy in Arabic script and artistic presentation. Judgment will be based on: Accuracy of Script, Neatness, Creativity and Design, Skill and Craftsmanship
Category : Seniors (9 to 12)		
Topic : (Will be given on spot)	20 min	Each participant should write a given short Islamic phrase within the allotted time. Participants may include simple decorative designs, but clarity of the text must be the primary focus. The artwork should reflect both accuracy in Arabic script and artistic presentation. Judgment will be based on: Accuracy of Script, Neatness, Creativity and Design, Skill and Craftsmanship

Speech Competition:

Category : Sub Seniors (6 to 8)	Duration	Remarks
Topic : The Muslim and Responsibility: At Home, School, and Society	3 min	Students should explain the responsibilities of a Muslim in daily life, including duties towards parents, teachers, friends, and society, in light of the Qur'an and Sunnah. They should highlight how good character, honesty, and respect reflect true Islamic values. Judgment will be based on: Qur'anic or Hadith references, Clarity, Fluency, Interpretation & impact
Category : Seniors (9 to 12)		
Topic: The Qur'an as a Guide for Modern Challenges	3 min	Students should explain how the teachings of the Qur'an provide solutions to modern-day challenges, such as stress, social issues, injustice, and moral confusion. They should demonstrate the relevance of Islamic guidance in contemporary life with appropriate Qur'anic and Hadith references. Judgment will be based on: Qur'anic or Hadith references, Clarity, Fluency, Relevance & interpretation

Adhan Competition:

Category	Duration	Remarks
Seniors (9 to 12) Asmaul Husna	2 min	Only for boys. Judgement will be done on the basis of Words of Adhan, Tajweed, melodiousness & Clarity

Asmaul Husna (4 boys & 4 girls per team):

Category	Duration	Remarks
(6 to 12) House-wise	3 min	Students should recite Asma'ul Husna clearly and accurately, with correct pronunciation (makharij) and proper rhythm/flow. They may recite all or a selected number of the Names as instructed. Emphasis should be given to clarity, confidence, and respectful delivery. Judgment will be based on: Accuracy of pronunciation, Fluency and flow, Memorization, Voice clarity, Confidence and presentation
