Requirements:

Timeline:

- Program Duration: **May until end of October**
- Submission & Review:
 - 1) My Kitchen Garden - **before 30 October**
 - 2) Electricity Audit – **May & June month and Sept & Oct bills to be submitted by 30 October**

- Awarded with Certificates of Appreciation
- **“Green Champion”** Title for the winning parent
