Dear Principals,

In line with our commitment to maintaining public health, protecting health of individuals, and preventing the spread of communicable diseases, and in collaboration with the Ministry of Health and Prevention (MOHAP) and Dubai Health Authority (DHA), the Abu Dhabi Public Health Center has launched the National Measles Immunization Campaign across the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

What is the National Measles Immunization Campaign?

The National Immunization Campaign aims to strengthen immunity in children aged 1 to 7 years with one dose of Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccine.

The National Measles Immunization campaign run from November 4, 2024, providing one dose of MMR vaccine to children aged 1 to 7 years, regardless of previous vaccination status, vaccination history, or previous exposure to measles, mumps or rubella infection.

What do we need from you?

To participate and contribute to the success of this National Immunization Campaign in schools in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi through distributing the "MMR Vaccination Consent Form" to all parents of the targeted students, in order to ensure that the campaign runs as required and achieves a high coverage rate.

The Ambulatory Healthcare Services-SEHA, a subsidiary of Pure Health will provide the MMR vaccine to students in the following grades (or their equivalents in different curriculums), during the academic year 2024/25.
