SCHOOL REOPENING – 2021-22 CIRCULAR TO ALL PARENTS

Dear Parents/Students,

Greetings! Hope you and your family are safe and in good health.

Please be informed that school will reopen for the new academic year on Sunday 11th April 2021 for grades KG2 to Grade 12 and on Thursday, 15th April 2021 for KG1. As per the ADEK approval school will continue the blended model for classes KG 1 to Grade 9 and Physical schooling for Grades X & XII. Students can attend online classes only from Abu Dhabi.

Parents of Classes KG to 9 are requested to fill the at survey in google form and send it back to the respective Supervisors/Class teachers on or before 2/4/2021.

Please go through the instructions given below with regard to the reopening of face-to-face classes & online classes.

- 1. Class Timing: Gr. 1-12: 7.50am to 2.10 pm. & KG Classes: 7.50am to 12 Noon. Students should enter the school campus between 7.40am to 7.50 am.
- 2. Home room period starts from 7.50 am onwards.
- 3. Attendance is compulsory and students who have chosen physical classes should attend physical classes on all days (Sunday to Thursday). Circular, instructions, homework and any future communication will henceforth be through portal and website and google class room only. Please ensure that your ward is regularly attending the classes and does not take leave unless it is due to unavoidable reasons.
- 4. Attendance is compulsory for all students who have chosen online classes on all days (Sunday to Thursday). Please ensure that your ward is regularly attending the classes and does not take leave unless it is due to unavoidable reasons.
- 5. It is compulsory for all students (above age 12) who are attending physical schooling to take the COVID test and submit the result to their respective class teachers before joining the physical class. (96 hours test result on 11th April). Students have to submit the health declaration form and travel declaration form (if travelled outside the country) before 7th April 2021.
- 6. Students should wear neat school uniform while attending the school physically as well as online classes. Uniforms can be purchased from the school uniform store.
- 7. Students should bring healthy food, snacks and enough water daily. Please note that school canteen will not function during this period.
- 8. All Students should wear mask to school without fail. They should have an extra mask in their bag.
- 9. Students must stay in their respective classrooms all day.
- 10. Sharing of food items, books, stationery etc. are strictly prohibited in school.

- 11. If your ward can handle the usage of sanitizer, please keep a small bottle in his/her bag. However automatic sanitizing dispensers are installed at multiple points in the school which can be used by the students.
- 12. School will take all necessary precautions to provide awareness about keeping safe distance and ensure students' health and safety at school. You are requested to advise your wards about the basic safety and health instructions to be followed to fight the COVID pandemic.
- 13. As informed in the parent guide, please do not send your ward to school if he/she has cold / fever / any other symptoms related to COVID infection.
- 14. For more details kindly go through the parents' guide on schools reopening uploaded in our school website.
- 15. Kindly pay the school fee online. Parents can enter the school campus only with a valid COVID test negative report of **96 hours** from DOH.
- 16. Timing for visiting the accounts office during school days is from 2 pm to 3.30pm and on Saturday from 9am to 1 pm.
- 17. Parents & visitors are not allowed to visit the school from 7.30 am to 2 pm on school working days. Visiting hours will be from 2.30 pm to 3.30 pm with prior appointment.
- 18. TRANSPORT: Due to the current COVID 19 situation the bus capacity is reduced to 50% so the cost of transport fee will be increased 50%. Parents opting for transport should pay the transport fee for 3 months in advance. Students will not be allowed to enter the bus without payment. Parents have to directly contact the transport company regarding location and timing. Fees once paid will not be refunded at any cost.
- 19. **Note Books & text books**: Parents can collect the Note books, text books and uniform from 8th April onwards from the store. KG text books and note books are available in store. Store working hours is from 9 am to 2 pm.
- 20. Please note that the current plan and date of school reopening is subject to change at any time based on the directives from ADEK/MOE.
