SUMMER VACATION : 1ST JULY 2021 to 28TH AUGUST 2021.

MODE OF LEARNING AFTER SUMMER VACATION: *We are pleased to inform you that ADEK has instructed us to open our school physically for all classes from August 29, 2021.
