

EMIRATES FUTURE INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY CIRCULAR TO ALL PARENTS MODE OF LEARNING FROM 24TH JANUARY 2022

Dear Parents/ Students,

Greetings! Hope you and your family are safe and in good health.

MODE OF LEARNING:-

Following the directives from Abu Dhabi National Crisis committee and ADEK regarding the physical return of students to school, it has been decided that a staggered physical return to school will come into effect as follows.

KG1, KG2 & Grade 1-5: FACE TO FACE LEARNING (Physical schooling)

Parents have the right to continue the distance learning option for their ward till 28th January,2022 and can shift to physical schooling option from 31st January,2022 after getting approval from the respective supervisor and class teacher.

A survey will be conducted today in this regard and parents can opt the mode of learning, for the upcoming week (24/1/2022 to 28/1/2022) and for the period from 31/1/2022 to end of Academic year (March 2022). Survey should be completed before 21st January 10 am.

Please note that you will not be allowed to change the mode of learning once you select an option for Distance Learning or Physical Schooling in any circumstance from 31st January 2022.

TRANSPORT: Transportation will start from 31st January 2022 only. Parents who wish to avail transport for their ward are requested pay two months payment in advance to the accounts department on or before 25th January 2022. Transport will be provided only to those students who register before 25th January.

<u>PCR TEST RESULT</u>: All students physically attending should produce a hardcopy of COVID 19 negative test result on 24th January, 2022 (taken within 96 hours) to enter the school campus. Hard copies of duly filled Travel declaration & Health declaration form along with the copy of the PCR test result should be submitted to the class teacher on 24th January and soft copies to be emailed by 23rd January 2022. Details about the Free PCR testing centers and Saliva testing centers are attached to this circular.

GRADES 6-12: Online classes will continue till Friday 28th January 2022 and physical schooling for all grades will start from Sunday 31st January 2022.

All students of grades 6 to 12 and students who opted for physical schooling are requested to get tested before three days of attending the class physically and hard copy

of the result to be submitted to the nurse on 31st January 2022 (At the time of entry into school).

Please note that the current plan is subject to change at any time based on the directives from ADEK/MOE/DOH.

It is important to note that Students and staff who have been abroad, cannot enter the school premises until they have obtained a Day 6 negative PCR negative test result, from their day of arrival.

If any of the student /family member was affected by COVID 19, kindly send the health declaration form to the respective class teacher before 23rd January 2022.

In case student or any family member experiences illness:

- 1. Physical schooling students must not be sent to school if and when the student or any of their family members are ill and experience symptoms like fever, common cold, running nose, cough, etc.
- 2. We urge you to keep the school informed about such cases and refrain from sending your ward to school.
- 3. Please note that if any student is observed to experience any such symptom, they will be isolated and his/her parents will be contacted by the school. Parents are expected to take the child home at the earliest.
- 4. Students will be allowed to resume Physical schooling classes only after submission of HAAD-approved Medical certificate from a doctor.

All parents are requested to note the following points if the student or any family member is COVID-19 positive:

- 1. The parent must inform the class teacher / Supervisor immediately.
- 2. The student must not be sent to the school from the very next day.
- 3. The student must be collected from school at the earliest, if you receive the report after sending your ward to school.
- 4. The student must be quarantined at home for a minimum of 10 days and observed for symptoms.
- 5. The child can resume physical schooling classes only after you email TWO consecutive negative COVID-19 test reports (of the student and both parents), Quarantine completion certificate (of parents) and discharge summary of student/parent after discharge from institutional quarantine (if applicable).

All parents are required to abide by these protocols as they are directives from ADEK. Let us work together to ensure the safety of all members of the school community – students, staff and parents.
