Emirates Environmental Group is conducting its 15<sup>th</sup> Cycle of the Environmental Drawing Competition 2021 with an aim in mind of educating the youth of today in line with the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals. This is a unique competition that engages students across the country representing different age groups and all nationalities. This platform gives us great hope that the future generation is left with good environmental values and habits that are practiced daily in their lives.

The topics chosen each year are of current relevance and worded carefully to stimulate critical thinking and curiosity in students, while effectively informing them of the latest world news to explore. The topics and details for this year are the following:

Age	Group	Topic	Drawing Substrates
6 - 8 years	1	Your Vision of Biodiversity by 2030	A4 sized drawing sheets
9 - 12 years	2	Dubai Expo and the Future of Sustainability	A3 sized drawing sheets
13- 15 years	3	Sustainable Recovery after the Pandemic	A3 sized art canvas

## MATERIALS TO BE USED

- The students of Group 1 and Group 2 can use any of the following mediums to colour their drawings; i.e. pencils, crayons, pastels or water colors.
- Students under Group 3 are required to submit Canvas Paintings and can use any of the following mediums to colour their drawings: i.e. charcoal pencils, water colour, oil colours.
- Do not write elongated messages on the artwork. This will incur negative marking.

## **SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES:**

- All artwork submitted to the competition must be an original idea and the creation of the student artist.
- Only one entry per each Student should be sent for the Competition as per the appropriate age group.
- Paintings that have been shown or accepted in other competitions will not be accepted.
- The entries will be assessed by a panel of qualified artists who will select the winners on the basis of creativity, imagination, composition, use of colour and choice of subject.
- From the School, best five will be selected from each age group and will be sent to Emirates Environmental Group (EEG).

Six (6) winners from each age groups will be selected by the environmental agency. Winners will be invited to attend EEG's Environmental Drawing Competition Awarding Ceremony on the 21st May 2021; where they will be awarded prizes and certificates. All the participating schools and students will get an E-certificate.

Interested students can give their names to the respective class teachers on or before  $22^{nd}$  February 2021 and the submissions for the competition will be accepted no later than  $2^{nd}$  March 2021.
