

Subject: Updates to the Policies and PCR Testing Requirement

### Dear Principals,

Reference to circular PE/K12E2022/002, kindly note the below important policy updates and PCR testing requirements which will be applicable starting from next week 24 January 2022:

### • Entry requirements:

- School staff and students returning physically to school must have a valid 96-hour negative PCR test on their first day back at school. This also applies to school staff who have already returned to school during the distance learning weeks as they are still required to present a valid 96-hour negative PCR test on their first entry to school as of next week
- School staff and students will be required to maintain a valid 14-day negative PCR test
- School Staff and students aged 16+ must present a green pass on Al Hosn App as an additional entry requirement
- Parents and visitors will be required to have a valid 96-hour negative PCR test and a green pass on Al Hosn App to enter the school building
- Parents picking up/dropping off their children only require a green pass on Al Hosn App. They do not require a 96 hours valid negative PCR test if they only enter to a designated pick up area without interacting with school staff within close proximity

### Return from travel:

- \* All individuals (School staff, third-party contractor or student) that have been abroad cannot enter the school premises until they have obtained a Day 1 and Day 6 negative PCR tests from their day of arrival in addition to any other entry requirements
- You are required to maintain travel declarations for students and staff

### School Field trips and activities:

- All field trips are suspended until further notice
- Sport and cultural activities can continue in line with approved precautionary measures

Please make sure you adhere to all other precautionary measures in the Private Schools Reopening Policies and Guidelines unless it is conflicting with the above.

The first-entry and in-school routine PCR testing will be provided for free. The details of which will be shared shortly.

Subject: PCR Testing Schedule and Location for School Staff and Students

### Dear Principals,

In reference to circular PE/K12E2022/003, please find below the PCR testing dates and instructions for the first entry PCR test.

### First Entry PCR Test for Students:

- Students can avail a free PCR test at any private or public clinic, hospital, or drive-through test center without the need to present a designated school code. They will be required to show their Emirates ID (or Passport if their Emirates ID has not yet been issued)
- Students below the age of 12 and Students of Determination can choose to get a free saliva test at any of the designated Saliva Test Centers in Abu Dhabi, Al Ain and Al Dhafra (list attached)
- Free PCR testing will be available from 20 to 31 January 2022 to accommodate for various student start dates
- We advise students who will physically go back to school on the following Mondays to test within the below ranges to ensure they get their results in time:
  - Students returning on Monday, 24 January 2022 are advised to test from 20 to 22 January 2022
  - \* Students returning on Monday, 31 January 2022 are advised to test from 27 to 29 January 2022

### First Entry PCR Test School Staff (including Third-party Contractors):

- School staff can avail their free PCR test at designated centers using their school codes and Emirates ID or Passport if the Emirates ID has not yet been issued (see designated centers and codes attached). Alternatively, they can choose to get their tests at a private screening center at their own cost
- School staff who will physically go to school are advised to test from 20 to 22
   January 2022 to ensure they get their results in time

We will also continue to arrange in-school PCR testing, we will communicate the details with you separately.

Please communicate the back-to-school (first-entry test) requirements to your students and staff promptly.
