- Create a dedicated classroom space within your home.
- Create a schedule that includes incorporated dedicated time into each day for learning. When you make a plan, think about the time your child is most likely to give his or her best work and attention.
- Help young children to develop good habits in using electronic screen products, including proper sitting posture and using skills.
- Make sure children use electronic screen products with your help.



- Make sure they have off screen activities as long duration of use of technology is forbidden to ensure sufficient rest for eyes.
- Support emotional balance by providing more time for quality parent-child activities like talking, reading, playing games, drawing, colouring and doing physical activities.



- Place the computer in an open area accessible by parents to provide timely guidance. Ensure that the learning space is always clean and disinfected.
- Talk positive about the classes and build interest in your ward, so that he or she looks forward to attend and learn everyday.
- Install filtering software with children's consent to avoid them getting access to inappropriate materials.
- Equip children to avoid making friends only known online and teach them to protect their own personal data and privacy of oneself and others.



- Have some understanding on the applications and webpages used by children and provide other guidance when necessary.
- Make sure your kids take plenty of breaks in order to get physical activity and time away from screens. Ensure that they do some eye relaxing exercises between each session.
- Be a role model for children in showing respect to individuals, especially their teachers and abiding to the laws in the community and in the virtual world.



- Educate children to be responsible, respectful, disciplined and empathetic.
- Strengthen the awareness to protect personal privacy as well as the understanding on laws and regulations related to computer crimes.
- Teach them to report when they come across online cheating or cyberbullying.



Gain freedom, privacy, recognition and respect from others.

- Understand youth culture and make sure they do internet activity only with your consent.
- Understand online risks and guide them.(e.g. online friendship, pornographic information, cyberbullying, etc.)
- Offer an environment to develop mutual trust and sharing culture in family.
