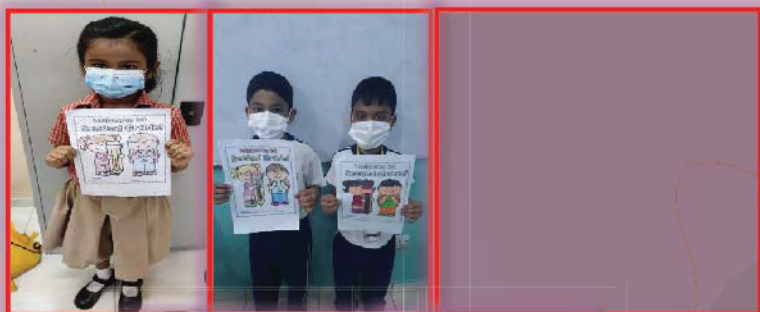

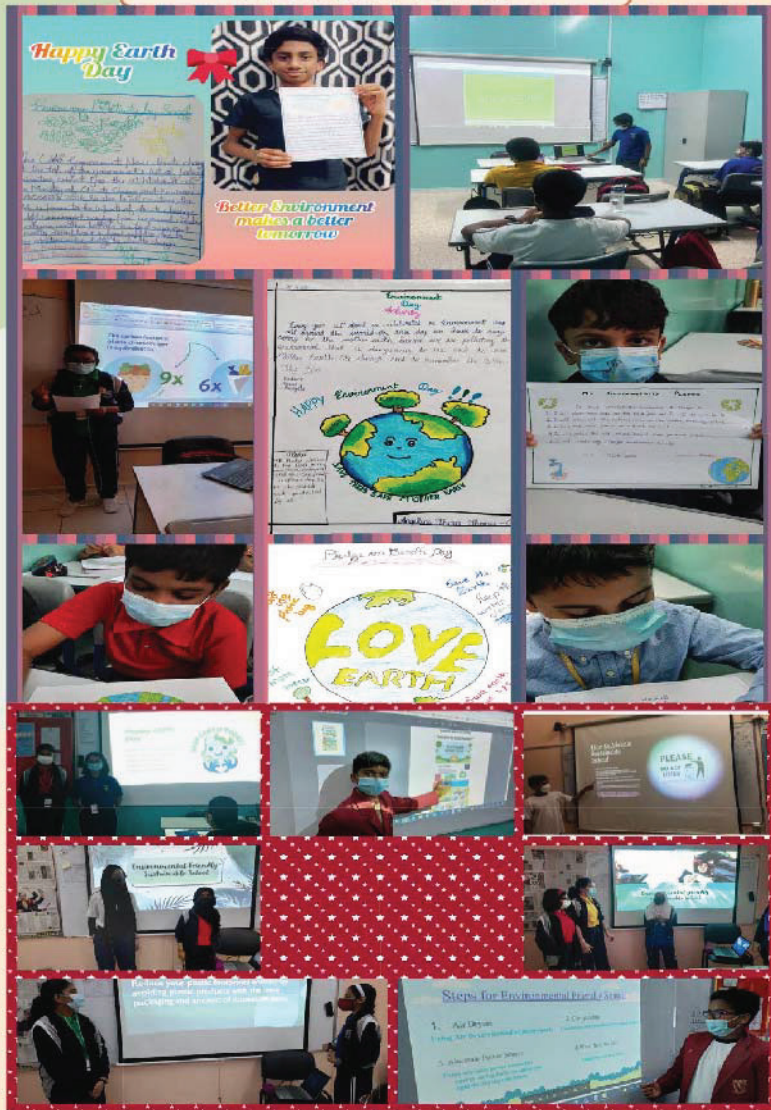

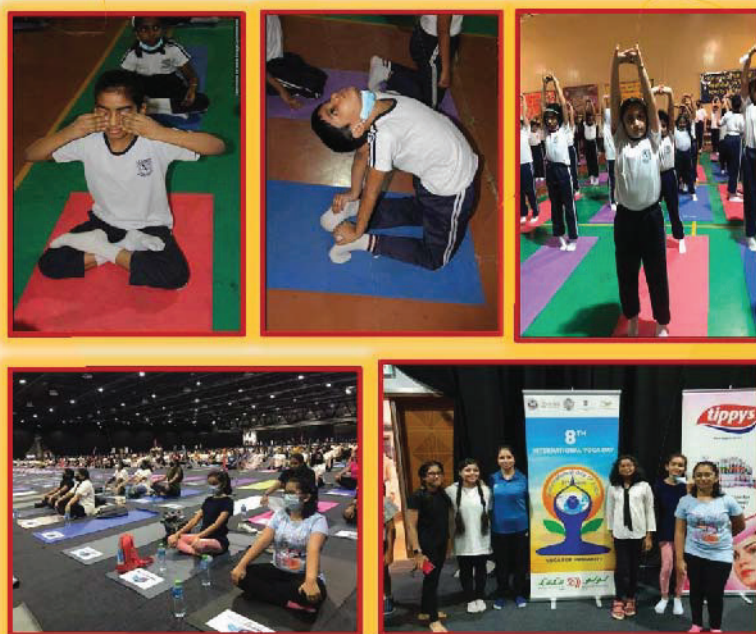

## TEACHER'S DAY

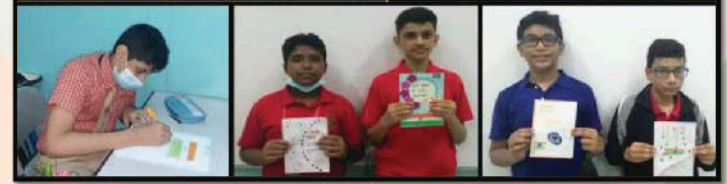

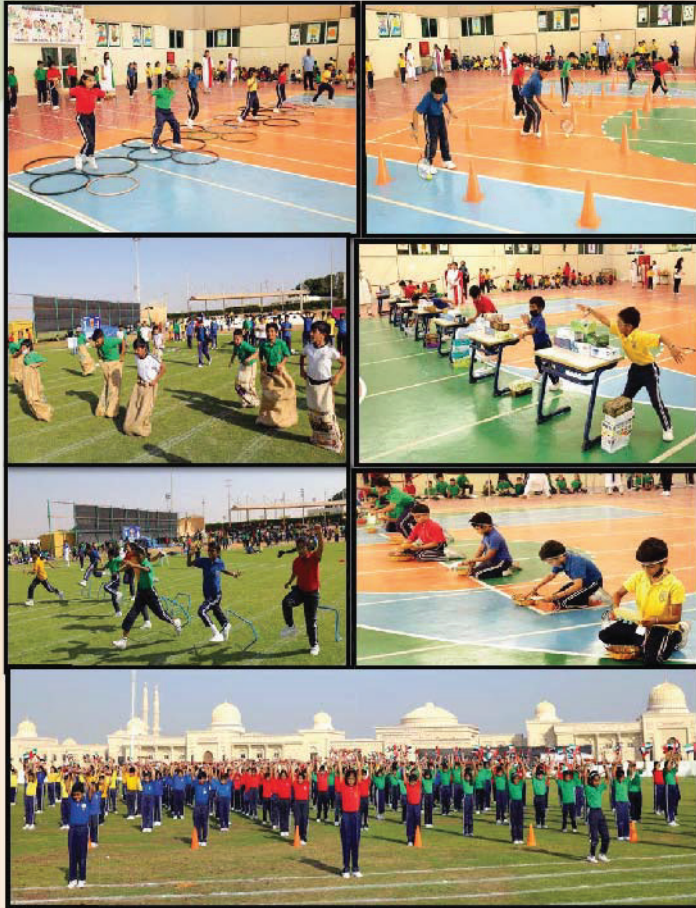
## UAE NATIONAL DAY

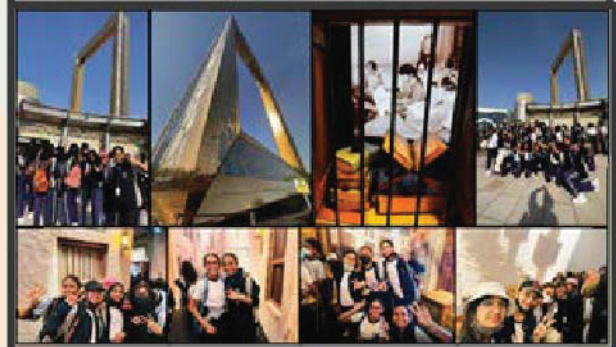
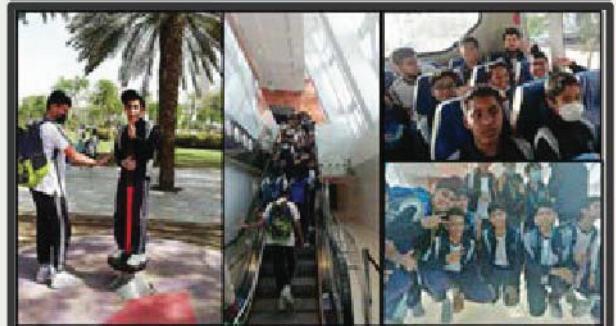
**TRIP TO DUBAI FRAME**

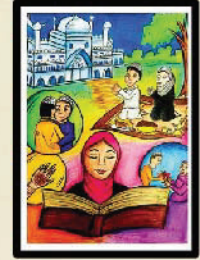

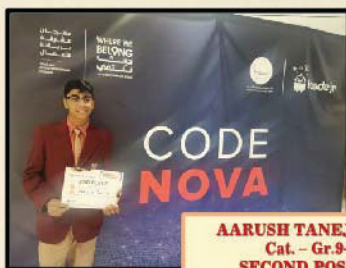
