CIRCULAR (Grade-X)

Dear Parents,

Subject: Two levels in CBSE Grade X Mathematics

CBSE vide Circular No.Acad-03/2019 dated 10th January 2019 has declared that two levels of Examination will be conducted only in the Mathematics Board Examination from Academic Year 2019-20. This has been introduced to reduce the stress of the students for Mathematics Exam.

The nomenclature for the two Examinations will be; **Mathematics-Standard** (with Code 041) and **Mathematics-Basic** (with Code 241) for the easier level of examination. The syllabus, class room teaching and internal assessment for both the levels of examination would remain the same; so that the students get an opportunity to study the whole range of topics throughout the year.

As per CBSE Circular No.Acad-22/2020 dated 01.04.2020, students who have passed Mathematics-Basic (241) at secondary level are eligible to opt for 'Applied Mathematics' (241) at Senior Secondary level.

In case student fails at any level of Mathematics, he/she can appear at the compartment examination as per norms of the Board according to the options given below:

In case of failure in	Compartment options
Mathematics - Basic	Mathematics - Basic
Mathematics - Standard	Mathematics Standard or Mathematics - Basic

A student who qualifies the Mathematics-Basic, shall be given an option to appear in Mathematics-Standard at the time of Compartment exams as per norms of the Board, in case he/she changes his/her mind to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary level.

Design for both the levels of question papers as per curriculum are available on the CBSE Academic website (www.cbseacademic.nic.in).

Depending upon the student's aptitude and abilities, decide upon the level of Board examination and submit your acceptance for the subject through the consent form given below on or before 28th June 2022.
