Learning Objectives: To understand the spatial concept and to co-relate with their surroundings.	Parents can reinforce the value of number3 & 4 through this fun activity.  Directions: Roll out play dough and make numbers. Give the numbers and toothpicks to your ward on a tray. Have your child count the number of toothpicks that matches the play dough number or you can count them together. Poke toothpicks into the play dough (number 2 would get 2 toothpicks & so on.

WORD FAMILY MATS  Family picture mats and accompanying word cards will help your child gain confidence reading words in short 'e' vowel word families.  The picture clues give extra support to your ward. These mats are a great vocabulary builder, too! Print and laminate each mat on sturdy cardstock. Cut them apart and stick velcro dots to the pictures and backs of the cards. Take off all the cards. Have your child read the name of the family in the center of the board. Then have him read each card and match it to the picture. After a few times of doing this with you, this is something your child might be able to do himself.  Simple sentences with the two/three-letter words of vowels "e" should be spoken & encouraged at home.
