EVS	<ul> <li>Living &amp; Non Living</li> <li>My neighborhood</li> </ul>	Activity: Teachers will hold a free and structured conversation about common buildings in the neighborhood like hospitals, fire departments, restaurants, chemists, etc. their functions or the services they provide Learning Objectives: To identify public buildings. Associates objects and people with public buildings. Activity: The teacher will display related flashcards, puppets & ask them about the occupation & the things related to it.	Do a fun quiz on living and nonliving things with your ward. You can speak names of living and nonliving things such as bird, chair, cap, baby, and so on. Now tell your ward to raise hands for every living thing.  Living and Nonliving Things  Talk with your ward about the importance of being thankful and polite towards all the people who help us with their work, both inside and outside the house.

English	<ul> <li>Concept of, one and many)</li> <li>Writing of Sight words through sentences(This, That, These &amp; Those)</li> <li>Sight words(Dolch words list -3)</li> <li>Toughy Turtle</li> </ul>	Activity: Word Games/ word buildings. Learning Objectives: To use these sight words in their daily conversation. To name &create small words with the sight words. To differentiate between one & many concepts.  This is an apple. That is an apple. Those are apples.	One way to help your ward to identify his/her sight words in sentences is to play a modified version of 'I Spy'. Instead of looking for objects, they are tasked with finding sight words. Give them a highlighter or highlighter tape to cover the word once they have found it.  Create incidences or situations pointing to near & far objects, ask the question to your child: What are these? What are those?  Encourage them to identify sight words within an age-appropriate story or book. In addition, you can ask your child to write out a sentence with a specific sight word in it or you may try writing out sentences for them and allow them to circle the sight words themselves as you say them.
