Subject: ASSET for Grades 3 to 9

Sharjah Private Education Authority (SPEA) has recognized **ASSET** (Assessment of Scholastic Skills through Educational Testing) as a required assessment for all Indian Curriculum Schools and made **ASSET** a mandatory exam for all students of Grades 3 to 9.

ASSET is a unique test that checks the depth of students' understanding of **English, Mathematics, and Science**. ASSET papers are designed by subject experts who specialize in designing questions that test the understanding of a concept in an interesting manner. This makes the testing experience stress-free and fun for students. Students benefit greatly from the individualized analysis, remedial instructions, and questions that they can use to practice at home. These tests give extremely useful feedback for sustained improvement in academics.

After the ASSET test, every student will receive a personalized online comprehensive review of his/her performance, along with detailed insights on his/her strengths and areas that need improvement, and will also get benchmarked with his/her/ peers across the country and internationally, to help them understand where they stand, along with targeted practice questions.

The tests will be conducted in the school and dates will be scheduled anytime in January / February 2025. Dates relevant to your ward's grade will be informed accordingly.

Preparation for ASSET:

- Mock Test will be carried out prior to ASSET exam. The details will be intimated by respective Class Teacher.
