2. WATER CONSERVATION

CBSE Expression Series on Water Conservation "Save water for Today, or Tomorrow you will pay."

Without water, life is not possible on the earth. Being residents of the UAE, an Arabian desert, we totally rely on desalinated water from the sea. Hence water conservation is very important.

Leaders Private School, Sharjah has taken up the initiative to save water, by installing water saver taps instead of the older, normal taps. This step facilitates the conservation of up to 70% of the water that had been previously used.

Students practiced using less water both during school hours with the use of the specialized water saver taps. They were able to take a proactive approach towards the issues of water wastage and the need for its conservation. The taps ensure that the increased flow of water is prevented and that the tap stays 'ON' only for a preset amount of time. The time crunch makes the students take more efforts to reduce their water usage. These taps have been able to set the bar for the beginning of a new habit of conservation and wastage prevention among all the students at Leaders Private School, Sharjah.

We also have taps which have button to activate the flow of water. When the force of water pushes out the button the flow of water also stops to prevent overflow which in turn conserves water.
