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### 1. ORGANISING SPORTS ACTIVITIES

# 3. SWACHHATA ABHIYAAN

"A clean India would be the best tribute India could pay to Mahatma Gandhi on his 150th birth anniversary in 2019," said Shri Narendra Modi, as he launched the Swachh Bharat Mission as a National Movement in New Delhi, on 2nd October 2014. The campaign aims to achieve the vision of a 'Clean India' by 2nd October 2019.

Perceiving the vital role of spreading awareness about the Swachhata Mission and its implementation across the country, our school organized various activities across all grades, from 1st to 15th September, 2019.

The main objective of this activity was to create awareness about the reduction of waste materials and the reuse of the materials through art and craft. Students collected various types of waste materials from their surroundings and prepared very creative and innovative models and art items, with these materials.

It helped the students to develop their fine motor skills while using different kinds of materials and also encouraged them to use waste material for making decorative and useable items.

The High School students participated in the 'Pick-up Campaign' by picking the litter after recess. They also wrote poems about 'Swacchtha' and gave a one minute 'On the Spot' speech, on topics related to 'Cleanliness' incorporating interdisciplinary links.

The commitment and the passion of the students in understanding the significance of cleanliness, were quite remarkable as was visible in the Special Assemblies on Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan, conducted by the students.

The values like preservation, recycling, conservation, reduce, reuse etc. were imbibed in the young hearts and minds by demonstrating this noble act of caring for our environment.














# 4. TERI-GREEN OLYMPIAD 2019
