CBSE ASSESSMENT SCHEME (MIDDLE EAST REGION) FOR GRADE X BOARD EXAMINATION

Dear Parents

Greetings!

This is to inform you that CBSE has issued a notification on 18.03.2026 regarding the preparation of Grade X results for students in the Middle East region. As you know, the Grade X Board Exams were cancelled earlier (circular dated 05.03.2026) due to the situation in countries, including the UAE and other Middle East regions. To ensure fair and timely results, CBSE has introduced a special assessment scheme. The details of which are outlined below:

Exams conducted between 17.02.2026 and 28.02.2026 were completed successfully. The result of your child will be calculated based on the number of exams they attended. Students who attended all exams will get marks based on actual performance. For those who appeared in fewer exams, marks for the remaining subjects will be calculated using averages of the best subjects attended. Students who changed their exam centre will have their results based on performance at the new centre. For students of 2025 or earlier with pending exams, CBSE will provide an opportunity in the second Board exams.

HOW THE RESULT WILL BE CALCULATED	
Exams Attended	How Marks Will Be Calculated
All exams	Marks based on actual performance.
4 exams	Remaining subjects' marks = average of the best 3 subjects.
3 exams	Remaining subjects' marks = average of the best 2 subjects.
2 exams	Remaining subjects' marks = average of the 2 appeared subjects. (Very few students fall in this category.)
2025 or earlier, up to 2 subjects	If exams attended → marks based on actual performance. If any exam is pending → opportunity in the second Board exams.
Changed exam centre	Marks based on performance at the new examination centre.

Results will be announced along with all CBSE students; internal assessment marks are final; no extra or special exams will be conducted beyond what CBSE has announced; and CBSE's decision is final. Grade XII assessment details will be shared separately once received.

Please check which category your child falls into (based on exams attended). No separate application is required, as CBSE will apply the scheme automatically. If your child changed the exam centre and the relevant documents are pending, kindly submit them immediately. We understand this is a stressful time, but the scheme is designed to be fair and transparent, ensuring no student is disadvantaged.
