Kindly note that, as part of the preparation for the CBSE Board Examinations (2025–26), the school conducts Model and Pre-Board Examinations for students of Grades 10 and 12. These examinations play a crucial role in helping students prepare effectively for the Board Examinations, as the question papers are designed in accordance with the latest CBSE sample papers, examination pattern, and marking scheme.

The Model and Pre-Board Examinations familiarize students with the updated examination format and help them approach the Board Examinations with greater confidence. Performance in these examinations also serves as an important indicator of a student's level of preparedness for the final Board Examinations.

Parents are therefore requested to ensure that their wards appear for the Model and Pre-Board Examinations with thorough and consistent preparation, as these examinations closely replicate the actual Board Examination environment.

Students are instructed to attend all Model and Pre-Board Examinations strictly in accordance with the school's assessment policy and examination guidelines, in order to maintain the sanctity of the examination process. It has been observed in previous years that some students reported late for these examinations. Please note that punctuality is mandatory, and examination timings will strictly follow the CBSE Board Examination schedule. Students reporting late will not be permitted to enter the school premises, and requests for rescheduling examinations will not be entertained under any circumstances.

It is further reiterated that the Pre-Board Examination results for Grade 10 will serve as a decisive criterion for determining eligibility for admission to Grade 11 for the academic year 2026–27. The weightage of the Pre-Board Examination will be considered while preparing the merit list, as well as for the allotment of streams and optional subjects. The cut-off marks prescribed for admission to Grade 11 will not be revised under any circumstances. Therefore, it is imperative that all Grade 10 students attempt the Pre-Board Examinations with utmost seriousness and thorough preparation.

We seek the full cooperation of parents and students to ensure the effective implementation of the above and to support students in achieving their best possible outcomes.
