CONDUCT OF PLACEMENT TEST FOR ADMISSION TO GRADE 11- AY 2026-27

Dear Parents & Students (of Grade 10)

Greetings!

As part of our admission process to identify eligible students for Grade 11 for the academic year 2026–27, the school will conduct a Placement Test on **Friday, 13th March 2026**.

It is mandatory for all students seeking admission to Grade 11 in this school to appear for the Placement Test as per the schedule provided below:

Date of Screening Test	Time of Exam	Reporting Time	Venue
Friday, 13th March 2026	9 AM to 11 AM (2 hrs.)	08.45 AM	Senior School (PS-1)

The Grade 11 admission (rank) list will be prepared based on the students' overall score in the Placement Test along with their Pre-Board examination marks.

It is important to note the below cut off marks for considering admission to Grade -11 during the AY 2026-27

(a) Cut-off percentage in the overall score for inclusion in the rank list for allotment to the **Science stream: 60%**

(b) Cut-off percentage in the overall score for inclusion in the rank list for allotment to the **Commerce stream: 50%**

Students who do not meet the above-mentioned cut-off percentage in the placement test will not be considered for admission to any of the streams.

Important Note: -

- All questions will be based on the Grade 10 syllabus and its application.
- The question paper will consist of two sections: Section A and Section B.
- Section A will contain 50 multiple-choice questions (MCQs), each carrying 1 mark.
- Section B will consist of descriptive-type questions (answers may be in a word, phrase, number, or 2–3 sentences), each carrying 1 mark.
- The maximum marks for the Placement Test will be 75. The total duration of the test will be 2 hours only.
- No request for rescheduling or re-testing will be entertained under any circumstances. Therefore, all students seeking admission to Grade 11 for the academic year 2026–27 are advised to plan their holidays and other activities after the Placement Test and must appear on the scheduled date.
- Students seeking admission from other schools must submit their Pre-Board marks, duly authenticated by the Principal of their respective school, to the Admissions Department at the time of reporting for the Placement Test.
- Students whose names appear in the rank list must attend an orientation session with the Grade 11 faculty (schedule to be announced) to finalize their optional subjects before admission is confirmed in the allotted stream. Optional subjects, once selected, will not be changed under any circumstances.
- No recommendations for admission will be accepted. Admission will be granted strictly on the basis of merit and rank list position.
