MANDATED ASSESSMENT BY ADEK

Dear Parents & Students,

Greetings!

Pursuant to ADEK Assessment Policy it is mandatory for students from Grade 3-9 to participate in Standardized Benchmark Assessment (SBA). The school has opted ACER-IBT as our SBA and the test window will be active between 3rd November to 26th November 2025. Effective involvement of parents is a requisite to support their children in to perform better in the above SBA.

The assessment measures English, Mathematics and Science. The test is crucial for the following reasons.

- It assesses student's knowledge and understanding in core subjects' over time
- It compares current and previous performances of the students.
- It indicates possible learning gaps and identifies next steps to meet the diverse learners needs.

The test result will be reflected with achievement band in RAYAH platform

Guidelines:

- Students are to mandatorily **bring their eSIS ID** as unique identifiers for login.
- Questions in the test are multiple-choice questions with four options and may include a few Technology Enhanced Items for example, drop-down, multiple selections, fill in the blanks etc.
- Test Duration -1Hour
- Students have been regularly practicing skill-based real-life application and critical thinking questions in the class.

The detailed schedule for the test will be shared by the respective class teachers. They will coordinate with the students on the day of examination for the smooth conduct of it.

It is mandatory for 100% students to participate in the test. Hence, no leave /absence will be granted during the test day for each grade and subject.

We wish all our students the very best for the forthcoming IBT exam and hope that they will exceed the targets set for themselves.
