### STANDARDIZED BENCHMARK ASSESSMENT AND ITS IMPORTANCE

Dear Parents & Students

Greetings!

In line with the **ADEK School Assessment Policy**, it is **mandatory** for all students from **Grade 3 to Grade 9** to participate in the **Standardized Benchmark Assessment (SBA)**. The policy emphasizes the importance of involving the entire school community—including parents—in actively supporting their children's academic progress. Parents are also expected to interpret and engage with the performance data available on the **"RAYAH" Parent Portal**, initiated by the Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK), Abu Dhabi. The assessment [IBT] will be conducted at this school in **November 2025**, and the detailed grade wise schedule has already been shared with the parents and students.

The IBT evaluates students' proficiency in **English, Mathematics, and Science** (for non-MOE schools) and serves as an essential tool for:

- Assessing students' knowledge and understanding in core subjects over time.
- Comparing current performance with previous achievements.
- Identifying learning gaps and determining next steps to address diverse learning needs.

To ensure effective parental awareness and involvement, a **mandatory online Parent Orientation Session** has been scheduled for the parents of Grade 3 to 9 students as follows:

**Date:** Wednesday, 29th October 2025

**Time:** 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

The session aims to help parents understand the following key areas:

- The significance of the Standardized Benchmark Assessment (SBA).
- The role of subject tests and assessments in the student progress report.
- How to interpret and support students using their assessment results.

**The meeting link** will be shared **10 minutes before the session begins**, and the **detailed schedule** will be sent by the respective **Class Teachers**.

All parents are **requested to attend the session on time** to ensure complete understanding and support for their child's academic growth.
