CBSE CLASS XII ASSESSMENT SCHEME FOR WEST ASIAN COUNTRIES (2026)

Dear Parents of Grade 12

Greetings!

In light of the prevailing circumstances in West Asian countries, CBSE had cancelled all Class XII Board examinations scheduled from 16th March to 10th April, 2026, including those previously postponed in early March. An **Alternative Assessment Scheme (Notification No. CBSE/CE/SPPS/2026/2 dated 27th March, 2026)** has been put in place to declare results fairly and reliably.

Results will be declared based on the number of examinations a student has appeared for. Students who appeared in all registered subjects will be assessed on their actual Board examination performance. For those with pending exams, school-based assessments will be used. Specifically, the best of the Quarterly, Half-Yearly, and Final Pre-Board marks for subjects with 80 or 70 theory marks, and the Final Pre-Board marks alone for subjects with 60, 50, or 30 theory marks. If a student was absent in the Final Pre-Board, the immediately preceding Pre-Board marks will be submitted. Students who shifted their examination centre to India or another country will be assessed on their actual performance, and compartment candidates (2025 or earlier) whose exam was not held will be given an opportunity in the Supplementary Examinations in July 2026.

Practical and Internal Assessment marks have already been completed and uploaded by the school and will remain unchanged. The school will upload theory assessment marks on the CBSE portal between 6th and 13th April, 2026. Please note that once submitted, marks cannot be revised/reviewed, so students are advised to preserve all answer scripts from school assessments, as CBSE may call for verification at any time.

Photocopy and re-evaluation will be available only for subjects where actual Board examinations were conducted. Students dissatisfied with their alternative assessment result may be given a fresh examination opportunity by CBSE, subject to feasibility, and if availed, those marks will be final. Students who do not meet the qualifying criteria will be placed in the 'Essential Repeat' or 'Compartment' category, with Compartment Examinations scheduled for July 2026. All results will be declared together with the rest of the CBSE Class XII students.

The CBSE has also stated that at the time of preparation of results, if any other suitable action is required to be taken, the same will be decided by the Competent Authority of the Board and implemented for declaration of result.

We understand this has been a difficult time, and the school is committed to submitting every student's marks with accuracy and care.
