CIRCULAR NO.12 RESUMPTION OF FACE TO FACE LEARNING & SCHOOL TRANSPORT

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

Kindly be informed that based on the validation visit conducted by ADEK and the Abu Dhabi Civil Defence Department, the school has been granted a No Objection Certificate (NOC) to reopen and resume face-to-face (FTF) learning effective from Monday, 20 April 2026, with regular school timings.

Students who do not wish to attend FTF classes will continue to receive the online links for Distance Learning (DL) classes, as per the previous survey conducted (Circular No. 11 dated 16 April 2026). School bus transportation will also resume from 20 April 2026.

The school has already conducted a parent orientation for students who indicated their intention to attend FTF classes in the survey. **Parents and students are expected to follow the Operational Protocol for Protecting Students and Continuity of In-Person Education** issued by ADEK. Students who did not submit their option through the survey but wish to attend FTF classes from 20 April 2026 must inform their respective class teachers via email. Such students and their parents must read and understand the attached protocol prior to attending FTF classes.

Students who have opted for DL will continue to receive class links until the school fully transitions to FTF learning.

Please note that students with pending fees for the academic year 2025–2026, or those who have not paid the fees for the academic year 2026–2027, will be permitted to attend FTF and DL classes only after clearing all outstanding dues.

Furthermore, only students who have paid at least one instalment of the school bus fee will be permitted to use the school bus service effective from 20 April 2026.

Please note the **revised school timings**, which will follow a **staggered dispersal** to ensure smooth and safe movement of students:

Monday to Thursday:

- Foundation Stage (KG to Grade 2) : 7:50 AM – 1:40 PM
- Preparatory Stage (Grade 3 to 5) : 7:50 AM – 2:10 PM
- Middle & Senior Stage (Grade 6 to 12) : 7:50 AM – 2:50 PM

Friday:

- Foundation Stage (KG to Grade 2) : 7:50 AM – 10:15 AM
- Preparatory Stage (Grade 3 to 5) : 7:30 AM – 10:35 AM
- Middle & Senior Stage (Grade 6 to 12) : 7:30 AM – 11:25 AM

Further, it is important to note that, as per our revised accommodation Plan, Grade 5 students will be accommodated in the Junior Campus (PS2).
