## CIRCULAR NO.05 ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027 COMMENCEMENT-DISTANCE LEARNING & PARENT ORIENTATION

Dear Parents,  
Greetings!

As we begin the Academic Year 2026–2027, on **30<sup>th</sup> March 2026**, we embrace this phase with resilience and a positive outlook, viewing challenges as opportunities to explore new ways of learning and growth. The academic year will commence in Distance Learning Mode until further notice. The school will strictly follow the ADEK Distance Learning Policy and Guidelines to ensure continuity, quality education, and student engagement with a strong focus on their wellbeing. Meanwhile, the school has approached ADEK for permission to commence in-person learning as well, and approval for the same is awaited.

A Parent Orientation Sessions will be conducted on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2026 to provide guidance on learning platforms, schedules, expectations, and ways to support your child.

The school will follow a structured approach across all sections: play-based inquiry learning in KG, a hybrid model (synchronous and asynchronous) in Primary, and project-based learning in Middle and Senior sections. Class teachers will share the timetable and access details before classes begin.

For the effective implementation of Distance learning, all parents and students are required to review and acknowledge the attached **Distance Learning Code of Conduct**, as mandated by ADEK. **This acknowledgment must be completed either through a signed and scanned hard copy (to be sent to the respective class teacher) or via electronic confirmation prior to the commencement of classes (no later than 29<sup>th</sup> March 2026)**

Please note that **access to the Distance Learning platform will be granted only to those students whose parents and the students have submitted the required acknowledgment**. Students who fail to comply will not be provided access effective **30 March 2026**.

Students are required to keep their cameras on during live sessions throughout, and KG students must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Regular attendance and active participation are essential. Students missing two or more live sessions without prior notice, or showing signs of disengagement or distress, will be identified as At-Risk and supported through follow-up interventions. The school places the well-being of students and families as a top priority, with regular wellness check-ins and continuous support.

Further details regarding screen time, learning beyond school hours, and parent engagement will be shared during the orientation.

We appreciate your cooperation and partnership in ensuring a smooth and successful start to the academic year. Together, we will continue to support our students in learning, growing, and thriving.
