SCHOOL UNIFORM AND ID CARD

Students are expected to present themselves in a neat and tidy manner at all times. Uniform is outsourced and parent can collect the same as per the notification received from the school. It is mandatory for all students from Kindergarten to Grade 12 to wear approved school uniform on all school days. However, students have been in color dress on their birthdays and on special allowed occasions/ school events with the prior approval of the Principal. Though acceptable, it is highly required to ensure that the dress code should be the one which adheres the School Dress code and ADEK Cultural Consideration policy. School dress code, which is specified in student's Diary and in Code of Conduct clearly states about hair style, use of ornaments, covering body parts etc.

The school uniform must be worn appropriately at all times. Students are expected to wear the basic physical education uniform recommended by the school during the physical education period only. All members of the school's community should strive to demonstrate a high level of personal care in their dress and physical presentation. The school's administration will act on all issues (including dress and personal grooming) that detract or interfere with student learning. Boy's hair must not be below the bottom of the shirt collar and should not fall on the forehead. Hair should not be dyed and must be neat and tidy. Students are not allowed to colour / spike / gel their hair, wear nail polish, tattoo or any henna design. Students are mandatorily to wear school ID card during school hours to recognize the students by all school staff and during school trips in order to keep the children safe at all times.
