

## First Term Assessment- October'2020 - KG to GRADE 12

### Phase 1: Kindergarten

Assessment in Kindergarten is an ongoing process and teachers make continuous observations as children work and interact during different activities. Progress of the children is assessed by teachers against grade level expectations in the seven main areas namely: Personal, Social and Emotional development, Communication and Language, Health and Physical development, Literacy, Numeracy, Understanding of the World and Expressive Arts and Design. Assessment is done through observation, questioning and hands-on learning experiences.

For Distance Learning, evaluation will be done through the activities uploaded on Class Dojo as well as children's active participation in online sessions. Children's progress and achievements are recorded and maintained in the Student's Profile.

The observation of the child will be made as the child engages in both self-initiated and adult led activities. On the basis of the teachers' inferences from observations and ongoing assessments, child will be marked on any one out of the following three levels and the next steps will be planned:

**Emerging level:** Student's academic performance indicates growth towards meeting the grade level standards. It shows room for growth/improvement.

**Expected level:** Student's academic performance demonstrates knowledge and understanding that meets the grade level standards covered.

**Exceeding level:** Student's academic performance demonstrates knowledge, application and extension of the curriculum standards taught.

### Phase 2 (Grade 1 to 5)

The half-yearly assessment for all students will be conducted online by employing various tech tools which will be explained to the students and parents by the class teacher. Students will also be assessed on their class work and participation in the class. A percentage of the PT1 will be also considered for the first term grading.

The online test will be completely MCQ- Multiple choice questions

### **Phase 3 (Grade 6 to 8 )**

The half-yearly assessment for all students will be conducted online by employing various tech tools which will be explained to the students and parents by the class teacher. Students will also be assessed on their class work and participation in the class. A percentage of the PT1 will be also considered for the first term grading.

The online test will be completely MCQ- Multiple choice questions

### **Phase 4 (Grade 9 to 12 CBSE)**

**Grade 9 and 11 CBSE :** Students will be assessed online, by incorporating the traditional method and technology, and will be based on CBSE board pattern. Students will receive the questions online and answer sheets have to be uploaded on the link that will be provided. The teacher will monitor the students through webcam. All the answers sheets will be verified by the teacher using the supportive application.

**Grade 10 and 12 CBSE** (Board exam classes) All students of grade 10 and 12 CBSE will be required to come to school. School will follow board pattern for the question papers with regard to marks and weightage for different units. Evaluation of answer papers will be based on the CBSE guidelines

### **Phase 4 (Grade 9 to 12 KB)**

**Grade 9 KB:** Students will be assessed online, by incorporating the traditional method and technology, and will be based on KB pattern. Students will receive the questions online and answer sheets have to be uploaded on the link that will be provided. The teacher will monitor the students through webcam. All the answers sheets will be verified by the teacher using the supportive application.

**Grades 10, 11 and 12 KB :** All students of Kerala board exam classes (10,11 and 12) will be required to come to school. School will follow board pattern for the question papers marks and weightage for different units. Evaluation of answer papers will be based on the KB guidelines

All the safety measures and protocols for conducting the exam safely will be strictly implemented. DO support and encourage your wards to prepare well for the exam.
