

PROGRESS CHECK - KG 1 & KG 2

Dear Parents,

Greetings from KG Department.

We would like to inform you that our term 1 will be ending soon and we will be conducting progress checks for each student from 4th of October till 8th of October 2020. Your class teacher will share the time slots for one on one session on Class Dojo.

Students will be joining classes at 7.30 am as usual. The timings for the progress check will be from 7:45 -8:50 am for KG1 and 7:45- 9:35 am for KG2

It will be asynchronous learning time for all children during which the teacher will assign tasks to be completed. Meanwhile she will conduct one on one progress checks with the allocated students. You are requested to make a note of the timings and get your child ready as teachers need to strictly stick to the time slots given to all students.

Regular lessons will continue from 9:20-11:00 am for KG1 and from 10:05-11:05 am for KG2 during the week.

Expectations from individuals:**KG 1:**

Prepare a Model/Poster of Human Body Parts and label them. Students will be checked for their communication skills, description (names and functions of body parts), phonics awareness (Initial Sounds), number recognition(1-10) and writing (1-5), concept - 2D-Shapes, Writing skills for letters (s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o) and creativity.

KG2:

Choose any 1 habitat and create a model or poster. Students will be checked for communication skills, description (type of habitat and conditions), accuracy of the habitat (plants and animals), creativity, phonics awareness (Blending and segmenting), Numeracy (numbers from 1-10, concept - big and small) reading and writing skills. Students should be able to read and write at least 4 simple sentences.

Parents are requested to support their children and encourage them to become independent learners. We aim to check students' knowledge and progress to plan our lessons for next term. During progress checks we would like to see and listen only to your child. Assist your child if any technical issues arise otherwise please be away from your kids as so that we get a clear idea about your child's progress so that we can support him/her better.
