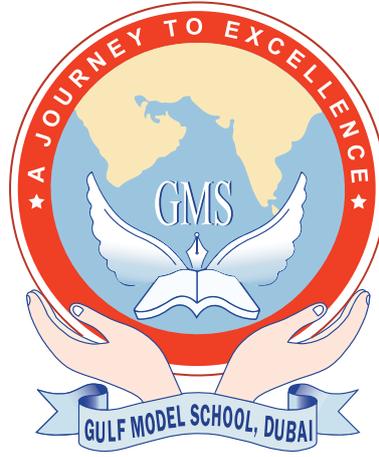

POLICY STATEMENT

The School fully understands the importance of a Governing Body that is experienced in the Education sector in Dubai. We have chosen to appoint an executive board complemented with a representative advisory committee comprised of teachers, administrative staff, parents and community members. Our Governing Body's role is to provide guidance and motivation to the school management and leadership team. The fundamental responsibility for the School's success lies within the vision of its Board of Governors.

OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY:

- Making appropriate information available to the school community

THE ROLE OF A DIRECTOR

Behavioral Responsibilities:

- Spiritual & emotional support for students, parents & staff members.



- Be a Role Model to the entire school.
- Support and guide the Principal to implement all the quality indicators for measuring the vision and mission of the school.
- To radiate the ethos of the school.

Functional Responsibilities:

- Secretary to the Board of Governors.
- Takes a leadership role in driving a collaborative process with the Board of Governors that would result in the development of goals, objectives and operational plans for the School
- Oversees preparation of the annual budget and other necessary financial documents as per the requirements and requests given by the School Principal and also provides information and justifications to Board of Governors in its budgetary review and approval process in consultation with the Principal. Cultivates a strong partnership with the Board of Governors in setting policies consistent with the mission of the School

Community Outreach

Our Governing Body is aware of the need to form working partnerships between the school and members of the community.
