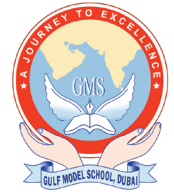

SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY



Substance abuse/illegal drugs means any unlawful, intoxicating or stupefying substances including tobacco, alcohol, prescription drugs or other hard drugs.

Substance abuse is prohibited and severe action will be taken against perpetrators.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY:

To make school a safe place.

The aim of this policy is to encourage all students to abstain from using any drugs (other than those which are medically prescribed) tobacco and alcohol. This document should be given to each student and their parents are required to sign it as acknowledgement that they have read and understood, and that they have agreed to abide by its policy.

EFFECTS OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE ON HEALTH :

Students with substance abuse will experience:

1. Inability to cease using drug
2. Poor work or academic performance.
3. Difficulty maintaining personal hygiene.
4. Changes in appearance e.g: weight loss
5. Risk taking behavior
6. Loss of interest in enjoyable activities.

ACTION THAT WILL BE TAKEN BY SCHOOL:

STEP 1: Parents will be notified

STEP 2: Warning memo will be issued by the supervisor.

STEP 3: Student will be suspended from school for 3 days.
