## **General Instructions**

## I. School timings

- i. School timings have been changed. All students must reach school by 7.25 a.m and join school assembly. School gates will close at 7.30 am. First period will start at 7.40 a.m.
- ii. School will get over, as follows:
- a. Classes FS2/KG1 to Yr6/Gr5: 2.10 pm, on all weekdays.
- b. Secondary school: 3.00pm on all weekdays.
- iii. Keeping to the Year level curriculum requirement of school hours, the timetable is shifted to 7 periods a day for Early Years & Primary and 8 periods a day for secondary school; with 50 minutes each duration. This has been done to reduce the load of books carried to school.
- iv. To make maximum use of the school time, all students are expected to be punctual. Late arrivals or absenteeism may impact behaviour marks.

### II. BYOD

i. We are happy to inform that all students of Yr7/Gr6 to Yr13/Gr12 are encouraged to bring their own device (BYOD), every Wednesday, starting 19th October 2022.

The BYOD would ensure that our students are empowered to look beyond the conventional norms of teaching and learning.

ii. Students are expected to read and follow Acceptable User Policy, which will be printed and sent home for both parents' and students' signatures. The signed copy should be returned to the respective supervisors by Tuesday, 18 October.



# III. School Dispersal

Kindly note the following:

- i. Gate No. 3 & 4 will be used only for bus transport. Parents should avoid bringing children to these gates.
- ii. Parents should use Gate No. 1, 2 & 7 to collect their children from school.
