Two levels of Board Examinations in Mathematics

Dear Parent,
Greetings!

"It has been decided by CBSE to hold two levels of Board Examinations in Mathematics for class 10 from the year 2019-20, which are as follows;

- 1. First level - Mathematics Standard - the same as existing examination**
- 2. Second level - Mathematics Basic - an easier examination**

The syllabus, classroom teaching and internal assessment for both levels of examination remain the same, only question papers for the Board Examination will be different for the two levels.

Based on the above declaration made by CBSE, the school has decided to execute this opportunity as detailed below;

1. Students who scored 55% or above in the PA 1 Examination will be given this choice i.e.; they can opt either for Mathematics Standard or Mathematics Basic for the Board Examination, 2021-22.
2. Students who scored below 55% in the PA 1 Examination will appear for Mathematics Basic in the Board Examination, 2021-22.
3. Please note that;
 - Mathematics Standard level is mandatory for students who wish to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary level.
 - Mathematics Basic level is for students who are not keen to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary level.

However CBSE offers an alternative for those who have opted Mathematics Basic to appear for Mathematics Standard at the time of compartment examination in case he/she changes his/her mind to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary level. **A detailed picture of this declaration can be found in the link provided below;**
