



Second Term School Reopening Circular for kindergarten

Date:25-8-2021

Dear Parent,

The school is all set to welcome back our students after the summer break. We will be following the latest updates from the Ministry to ensure a safe, healthy and rich learning environment for our students.

Mode of Schooling- Kindergarten

- 29th August to 2nd September - Online Learning through LMS
- We will continue online with the same timetable and timings i.e. 9:00 am to 12:00pm for all the students of KG 1 and KG 2.
- The school will offer both Onsite (on campus) face to face learning and distance/online learning on a daily basis from 5th September 2021.

Onsite Mode of learning: 1st Batch

- Students who have opted for Onsite will physically report to the school and it will be face to face learning.
- PCR test is not required for Kindergarten students.
- Timings for the same will be 7:30 am to 10:30am
- School transport (Bus Nanny will coordinate with the parents for bus timings)
- Students using their Own Transport will be dropped off from Gate Number 1.
- Parents will not be allowed to access the building.
- Entry after thermal scan from the reception.
- Pick up from KG Own transport area between 10:40 am to 10:50 am

Online Mode of learning: 2nd Batch

- Students who have opted for Online will attend online classes through LMS/ link shared by the class teacher.
- Timings for the same will be 10:30 am to 1:20 pm

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- All the students who have opted on campus face to face learning must submit Health declaration form and consent form latest by 4th September 2021 in the link - [Please click here to upload the form](#)
- Once the learning mode is selected students will not be allowed to switch learning mode in the middle of the school term.

Guidelines for Face to Face Mode of Schooling - Applicable from 1st October 2021

The operation protocol of educational institutes during the pandemic as per National Emergency Crisis and Disasters Management Authority is as given below. <https://twitter.com/NCEMAUAE/status/1429455912964591619?s=20>

- The protocol will be applied 30 days from the first day of school to give all unvaccinated individuals an opportunity to take the vaccine. During this period all vaccinated and unvaccinated students will be required to take a PCR test every two weeks.
- After 30 days unvaccinated students under 12 and vaccinated students aged 12 and over will have to take one PCR test per month.
- Unvaccinated students aged 12 and over, must conduct a weekly PCR Test. Distance learning will be available to vaccinated and unvaccinated students of all ages.
- Parents will be required to download Al Hosn application and present to the school printed PCR and vaccinated certificates.
- Parents are required to submit the Health Declaration along with the Consent Form for their wards if they are opting for onsite schooling latest by 28th August 2021. Please submit to the class teacher through Whatsapp number/email.
- Once the learning mode is selected students will not be allowed to switch learning mode in the middle of the school term.

We request parents to follow these directives as applicable to their wards. School will ensure all precautions and guidelines as issued by relevant authorities are followed and implemented.
