

<u>Grades 10 and 12</u> CBSE Board Exam Guidelines

Circular No: HB/AC/22.23/74 Dated: 17/02/2023

Dear Parents Greetings!

As intimated earlier through a circular regarding the commencement of Grade 10 and 12 Board Examinations, kindly make note of the following guidelines;

- 1. Students should report to school at 7.30am on all examination days.
- 2. From Habitat School, the teachers will take the students to their examination center (International Indian School, Ajman).
- 3. Attendance for all the students is mandatory and all students must be in complete school uniform.
- 4. After the examination all students will be brought back to Habitat School from where **Bus students** will disperse at 2.15pm by their respective school buses, while **OT students** shall be picked up by the parents between 12.30pm to 12.40pm from their respective OT areas.

Instructions for students during the exam

- 1. Students must write their Roll Number on the Question Paper.
- 2. Students should not write any answers on the Question Paper.
- 3. Students must carry their own stationery as no sharing will be allowed.
- 4. Students must be well disciplined and polite at all times at the Centre.
- 5. No mobile phones, Bluetooth, earphones, smart watch/spectacles or any other electronic gadget will be allowed.
- 6. All students should carry the following without fail to the Centre of the Examination:
 - → School ID Card
 - → CBSE Admit Card

- → Geometry Box
- → Blue-Black/Royal-Blue ink/gel/ball point pen & pencil
- → Transparent pouch only
- 7. No candidate is permitted to bring into the examination hall, books, bits of paper, old question papers, any communication device, wallet, etc. or any other material or reference of any kind which could be used for unfair means.
- 8. Actions will be taken as per the CBSE norms for all kinds of unfair means.
- 9. Centre Superintendent/Asst.Superintendent is authorized to check/frisk the candidates at the entry point and/or any time during the examination.
