Dear Parents
Greetings!

As intimated earlier through a circular regarding the commencement of Grade 10 and 12 Board Examinations, kindly make note of the following guidelines;

1. Students should report to school at 7.30am on all examination days.

- Attendance for all the students is mandatory and all students must be in complete school uniform with a blazer (PE uniform is not permitted).
- From Habitat School, the teachers will take the students to their examination centre to City School, Ajman.
- After the examination all students will be brought back to Habitat School from where **Bus students** will disperse at 2.15pm by their respective school buses.
- The students who go by bus, need to bring their next exam books, as they can prepare for it till 2.15pm.
- OT students** shall be picked up by the parents between 12.45pm to 1pm from their respective OT areas.

Instructions for students during the exam

- Students must write their Roll Number on the Question Paper.
- Students should not write any answers on the Question Paper.
- Students must carry their own stationery as no sharing will be allowed.
- Students must be well disciplined and polite at all times at the Centre.
- Electronic gadgets like mobile phones, Bluetooth, earphones, smart watch/spectacles will not be allowed.
- All students should carry the following without fail to the Centre of the Examination:**
 - **School ID Card**
 - **CBSE Admit Card**
 - **Geometry Box**
 - **Blue-Black/Royal-Blue ink/gel/ball point pen & pencil**
 - **Transparent pouch only**
- No candidate is permitted to bring any books, bits of paper, old question papers, any communication device, wallet, etc. or any other material which could be used for unfair means.
- Actions will be taken as per the CBSE norms for all kinds of unfair means.
- Centre Superintendent/Asst.Superintendent is authorized to check/frisk the candidates at the entry point and/or any time during the examination.
