Guidelines for Students

1. Students must attend all classes in complete school uniform.
2. Students should join the class on time using the links shared by the respective Class Teachers and Subject Teachers. Attendance will be recorded daily for each class.
3. Students must keep their cameras **ON** during the class and maintain proper discipline and decorum throughout the class.
4. Students must ensure they attend the class from a quiet and appropriate learning environment.
5. Students should keep a notebook and basic stationery ready to note down important points and instructions given by the teachers.
6. Meeting links should not be shared with anyone. No unauthorized persons should join the classes.

Books and Study Materials

→ Students can buy the textbooks later when the school intimates. Until then, students are advised to maintain separate notebooks for each subject as guided by the teachers during the bridge classes.
