Dear students,

Artista Drawing competition 2025 rules are given below.

- Art works should not contain any details like Name, Class, Division etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in registration form only.
- No one will be allowed to go out during the competition.
- Competition will be held on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2025 for the girls and 8<sup>th</sup> May 2025 for boys from class 1 to 12.
- Google forms must be submitted before 4<sup>th</sup> May 2025.
- Please refer the theme attached under the circular and prepare well for the competition.
- Poster making and News paper collage making competition gets 1.5 hrs. to show their creativity and all the other competitions are 1 hr. respectively.
- Students must follow the instructions of each competition as per the list.

ITEM	RULES
<b>1. COLOURING COMPETITION KIDDIES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Picture should be coloured in a way it looks best to you.</li> <li>• The completed picture will be judged on the basis of neatness, originality and exactness.</li> <li>• Picture will be provided from the school on the competition day.</li> <li>• Students can use color pencils, crayons or pastel colours for colouring.</li> </ul>
<b>2. PAINTING COMPETITION KIDDIES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students can bring any kind of paint for painting competition and chart paper with A3 size chart paper (11.7*16.5 inches).</li> <li>• Picture will be displayed in the classroom.</li> <li>• Students have to draw the picture on a paper and start painting.</li> <li>• The picture will be judged on the basis of colour mixing neatness, contrast and finishing.</li> <li>• Students must bring pencils, erasers, colour palette, brushes, water for colour mixing and tissues for cleaning.</li> </ul>
<b>3. WATER COLOUR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students can bring water colours, palette, brushes, water for colour mixing and tissues for cleaning.</li> </ul>

<p><b>COMPETITION SUBJUNIOR JUNIOR SENIOR</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students can bring white chart paper which is A3 size (11.7*16.5 inches).</li> <li>• A student must have a fresh idea.</li> <li>• Judgement will be based on relevance to the theme, originality, artistic composition, creativity, message conveyed by the art, effectiveness in communicating the intended message.</li> </ul>
<p><b>4. ACRYLIC PAINTING COMPETITION SUBJUNIORS JUNIORS SENIORS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students can bring acrylic colours, palette, brushes, water for colour mixing and tissues for cleaning.</li> <li>• Students can bring white chart paper or canvas which is A3 size chart paper (11.7*16.5 inches).</li> <li>• The painting will be judged on the basis of colour contrast, colour mixing neatness, finishing, creativity, principles and elements of art.</li> <li>• A student must have a fresh idea.</li> </ul>
<p><b>5. WASTE MATERIAL CRAFT COMPETITION SUBJUNIOR JUNIOR SENIOR</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material any kind of plastic, electronic waste or any second-hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.</li> <li>• The material will be rejected if not found to be waste product or second-hand item.</li> <li>• The materials used should be safe and not to pose any health risks to participants.</li> <li>• No ready or semi-finished model will be accepted from participant in competition.</li> <li>• Judgement is based on innovation, creativity, utilization of resources artistic composition &amp; design, eco-friendly rating and to get maximum practical benefits from products and to generate the minimum amount of waste and overall presentation.</li> </ul>
<p><b>6. POSTER MAKING SUBJUNIOR JUNIOR SENIOR</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A poster is made up of both text and images to make it eye-catching and informative. It is used for bringing about awareness on any issue of public interest.</li> <li>• Team shall consist of two members.</li> <li>• The poster must be made on the A3 size chart paper (11.7*16.5 inches) sheet with margins (0.5 inches) drawn with black pen/marker.</li> <li>• Poster can be made using pencil, crayon, watercolour, acrylic paint etc.</li> <li>• Photographs, wires other 3D objects, print-outs won't be acceptable. It should be original and handmade</li> <li>• Judgement will be based on relevance to the theme, originality, artistic composition, creativity, message conveyed by the poster, effectiveness in communicating the intended message.</li> </ul>
<p><b>7. NEWS PAPER COLLAGE COMPETITION JUNIOR SENIOR</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Making a collage involves binning many items and placing them on the same piece of paper to make one picture. It can be made by pasting different pictures on a piece of paper.</li> <li>• Team shall consist of two members.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students need to bring their own mats to sit and place the sheet and other material.</li> <li>• The collage must be made on the 52x37 cm size.</li> <li>• Team must submit a one page write up on the theme of their collage, neatly written in A4 size paper along with their chest number.</li> <li>• All materials must be brought by participants. White chart, Paper, magazines, glue, scissor, sketch pen/colours etc.</li> <li>• Team may disqualify on exceeding time or deviating from the theme or unsatisfactory explanation to judges.</li> </ul>
<b>8. PENCIL DRAWING COMPETITION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drawing must be on pencil drawing paper or chart paper with 25x35 cm size.</li> <li>• Acceptable tools of pencil drawing include black /white pen, pencils, colour pencils, graphite pencils, pastel pencils, charcoal sticks, white chalk, charcoal powder, rulers, erasers, compasses, protractors, paper and supports.</li> <li>• Stencils are not allowed in this competition.</li> <li>• Judgement will be based on relevance to the theme, originality, artistic composition, creativity, message conveyed by the art, effectiveness in communicating the intended message.</li> </ul>
