## SCHOOL OPENING FOR KG1 – 4<sup>th</sup> AND 12<sup>th</sup> STUDENTS

Dear Parent

As instructed by the Hon. Ministry Of Education, the onsite classes will be resumed in our school for **KG1 to 4<sup>th</sup> and class 12<sup>th</sup>** from **Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> January 2022.** At the same time, distance learning mode is continued for classes 5<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> till the end of this month. However, we anticipate full fledged onsite classes for all student to resume on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022.

## Kindly note the following:

## I. <u>Transportation Details: -</u>

- 1. Transport fee is applicable to only KG1 to 4<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> students in the month of January 2022
- 2. Transport fee is waived off for classes 5<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> students in the month of January 2022 if any
- 3. Parents, who have already made the payment for the month of January 2022, will be adjusted to next month fees.
- 4. Own transport parents must drop your wards before 7.30am and pick them back before 2:45pm at the designated gates only, as we cannot keep your wards in the school after the school dispersal by keeping the Covid-19 protocol.

## II. <u>Covid-19 Protocol</u>

- 1. All students are required to show a negative PCR test taken within 96 hours, and then required to undergo a PCR test every two weeks.
- 2. The green pass system on the Al Hosn App will apply to parents before they enter educational establishment, along with a negative PCR test taken within 96 hours.
- 3. School trips are suspended until further notice, while sports and cultural activities in schools will continue to apply relevant preventive measures.
- 4. The students who are detected Covid Positive may opt for remote learning on the basis of the report send to the class teachers from Al Hosn App.
- 5. We urge parent to start undergoing PCR tests for their wards to avoid overcrowding in testing facilities and to assure the safety and health of all.
- 6. The students who found symptomatic of Covid (cough, fever, headache, vomiting) can refrain from attending school on medical reports.
