EXAMINATION POLICY

PURPOSE

An examination policy outlines the rules, regulations, and procedures governing the conduct of examinations within an institution. It aims to ensure fairness, consistency, and transparency in the assessment process.

PROCEDURE

Classes KG to XII

1. School Examination (for KG and Grades 1-9 and 11)
2. Board examination: 80% (External) +20% (Internal) for Grade 10
And 50% (External) +50% (Internal) for only IT -Grade 10
3. Board examination: 80% (External) +20% (Internal) for Non-Skill based subjects
70% (External) +30% (Internal) for Skill based subjects

Board theory exam salient features:

1. Entire syllabus will be included in the exam.
2. Marks and grades will be awarded for individual subjects.
3. Eight- Point grading Scale for Scholastic Areas for grades KG - XII.

Periodic Assessment salient features (20 marks)

Will be completed through three different modes.

- (i) Periodic tests: 10 marks
- (ii) Class test (core subjects): 5 marks
- (iii) Subject enrichment activity: 5 Marks
- (iv) Subject enrichment (Non core subjects): 10 Marks

Half Yearly Exam in September

Written exam for 80 marks with entire syllabus of 1st term.

YEARLY EXAM IN MARCH

Written Exam for 80 Marks With Syllabus Coverage as below:

Classes I to VIII: Entire syllabus of 2nd term.

Subject Enrichment Activities (5 Marks)

These are subject-specific activities aimed at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students.

These activities are to be carried out throughout the term, however they should be evaluated at the term-end.

Discipline (Attendance, Sincerity, Behaviour, Values):

The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, tidiness respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others.

The school has Discipline Policy in line with the Behaviour Management Guidelines by the MOE. Each student is awarded 100 points in the beginning of the academic year. For the Discipline 80 marks and for the exemplary behaviour 20 marks are awarded for each student. The point deduction will be done according to the degree of defaulting. The points may be reverted if improvement shown.
