We are pleased to announce **The Brainstorm Battle (Inter-House Debate Competition)** for students of Grades **IX to XII** organized by **The Literary & Debate Club** of the school. This exciting event is designed to develop critical thinking, public speaking, and teamwork skills among our senior students.

Event Details:

Date: 24th June 2025, Tuesday

• **Time:** School Hours

- Participants: One team from each House. 2 speakers(boy/girl) per team one *for* and one *against* the motion.
- Each House will be represented by **2 participants** (1 for the motion and 1 against).
- Topics will be shared 2 days prior to the event.
- The debate will consist of two Rounds. In the Argument presentation Round,
 the participants are expected to share their opinions for/ against.
- In the **Objection Round**, each speaker will pose a question to any other member of the panel in the opposition such that all speakers get a question each.
- Time limit: 2 minutes per speaker, followed by Objection rounds.
- In the Objection Round, the participants will be given **15 seconds** for posing the question and **45 seconds** for answering.
- The decision of the Judges will be final.
