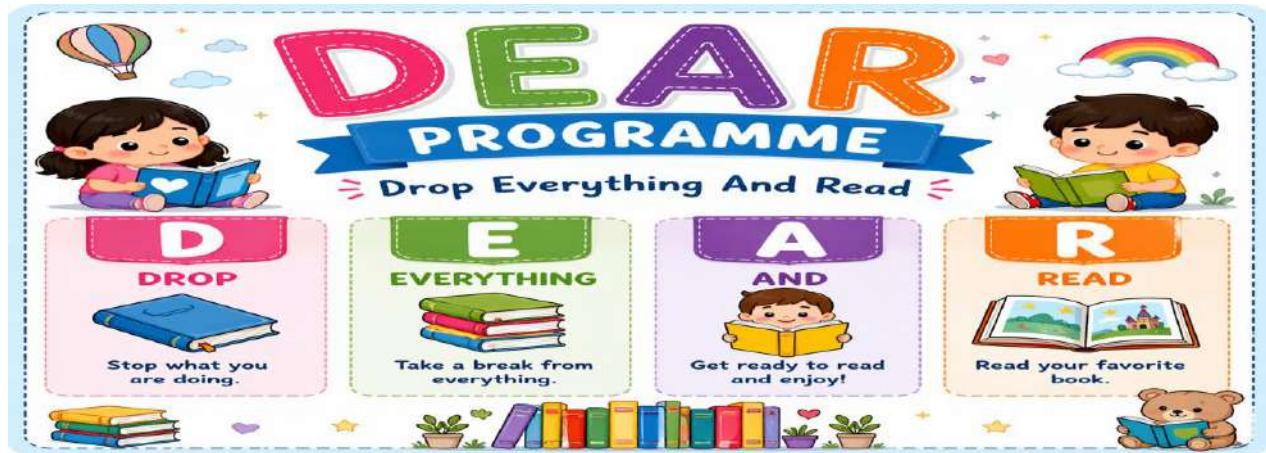




WORLD BOOK DAY CELEBRATION

The programme will be conducted on **Thursday, 23rd April 2026**, during regular class periods. On this day, students will participate in dedicated reading time, helping them build language skills and develop a joyful connection with books.

We strongly believe that reading becomes more meaningful when supported at home. We kindly request parents to actively participate in the following extended activities designed to promote both **reading habits and creativity**:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sit with your child and select a <b>child-friendly picture storybook</b>.</li> <li>• <b>3–4 sample storybook links will be shared in Google Classroom</b>. Parents may either choose from the given options or select a book of their choice.</li> <li>• Discuss the <b>characters, actions, and events</b> in the story.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to <b>predict what might happen next</b>.</li> <li>• Read the story aloud, making it interactive and expressive.</li> <li>• <b>Record your conversation and interaction</b> with your child and upload it in <b>Google Classroom</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Guide your child to create a <b>colourful mini storybook</b> (5–6 pages) with pictures.</li> <li>• Encourage <b>creativity through drawings, colouring, and simple sentence formation</b>.</li> <li>• <b>3–4 sample story links will be shared in Google Classroom</b>. Students may take inspiration from these or create their own story.</li> <li>• Submit the completed project to the class teacher <b>on or before 30th April 2026</b>.</li> </ul>
