

MoE Textbooks: As you know, the curriculum framework of UAE includes certain mandatory subjects as follows: Arabic (Pass% - 50), UAE Socio-Cultural-Moral Studies (Pass % - 40) and Islamic Studies (Pass % - 50 and it is prescribed only for Muslim Students). The MoE has already informed the School to insist the parents to get the original copy of the text books for their wards right from the beginning. Since the copyright is restricted, xerox copies of these books are not allowed. The School is left with no option but advising the parents strictly to do the needful for their wards.

<u>Stranger-Danger:</u> The School is doing its best to ensure the safety and security of the students especially at the dispersal time. The School has made a system to disperse the students in turns under supervision. Accordingly, the own transport parents had been advised to enter the campus and pick the child under the surveillance system through the rear gate. Our rationale to introduce such a system is:

- Prone to accidents may avoided

Unfortunately, some parents fail to understand the severity of the reality and with certain excuses, they urge their wards to get out of the campus unaccompanied by any adults. Once again, all such parents are informed that the School will bear no responsibility for the mishaps or any untoward incidents that were caused due to non-compliance of the School regulations.

<u>Unauthorized Absence:</u> Some students have not started attending the classes yet even after reminders. The names of the students who fail to report by 05th May 2023, may be removed from the roll.

<u>Heavy Bag Issue:</u> The School is finding some possible ways of reducing the weight of the Student Bags of Grades o1 to 05 through the following means:

- a) Holding some textbooks back in the School as per timetable:
- b) Utilizing available notebooks for more than one Subject
- c) Clubbing Periods of the same subjects limiting number of subjects a day.
- d) Reducing the class hours of Grade o1 (Still in discussion).
