



COMMUNITY SERVICE POLICY

- Community Service is an activity that is performed by individuals or as a group for the benefit of the institution / self and the community. It may be done for a variety of reasons
- 2. Students are required to perform 30 community service hours to graduate from high school.

Policy Statement:-

Work experience, which can also include volunteer or community service is a component of graduation.

Rationale or purpose of policy:-

This policy explains the importance of community service. The requirement recognizes the importance of experimental learning and the importance of extending education beyond the classroom into the community. Work experience, including volunteer or community service, supports students in both their career development and their human & Social development. This type of experiential learning increases the relevance of school by helping students connect what they learn in the classroom with the skills, knowledge and attitudes needed to be successful in both the workplace and the community.

Procedure related to policy:

To meet the minimum requirement for the work experience or volunteer or community service for graduation, students must provide evidence. The evidence must include an evaluation report, or signed form from a community agency or organization. The evidence must describe the nature of the work or service performed by students and must also report on tasks and duties performed and identify the skills used.
