Counseling

→ Steps to Meet the Counselor

- 1. Students may meet the Counselors walk-in basis on personal matters, issues, and problems during Breaks & other non-teaching times.
- 2. The Guidance Counselor discusses with the teacher and the student the issue being referred to at hand. The Counselor is prompt in responding to a referral, by meeting the student, class observation, and investigating. Records of follow-up are kept in the student's portfolio under observation by the Principal.
- 3. As part of the observation and monitoring follow-up, students will be invited for a counseling interview.
- 4. After a series of counseling and monitoring, a follow-up meeting shall be done to determine the extent of progress the student made with consultation from the teachers and with the parents.
- 5. All records are confidential and are only accessible to SLT & concerned members of staff and parents. Information may only be shared with an external agency with the written permission of the parents.
- 6. In case of any problems, parents shall be informed by phone or email to ensure optimum involvement and guidance.
- 7. Regular monitoring to keep track of students' progress and well-being.
