- ❖ **SCIENCE LABS :** The three well equipped science labs , Physics, Chemistry and Biology are built to meet the student's needs and syllabus as to allow practicals, and hands on experiential approach of learning. All safety measures as per their requirements and regulations are met.
- ❖ **MUSIC ROOM :** It is set aside inside the school and gives the students to participate in the functions and assemblies with full rhythm. With the help of musical instruments children are able to fulfill their ambition to play and learn the instruments.
- ❖ **OPEN STAGE :** It is ideal for conducting school assemblies, functions and days for celebration. It is used as a platform for Sports, Yoga and other performing Arts.
- ❖ **PLAY GROUND :** Play ground can be accessed for Basket ball, Foot Ball , Throw ball , Jumps and races. It provides a safe outdoors environment within the school that stimulates children to use their creative energy in healthy interactions with one another to keep them active.
