**Launching the 9th Cycle of the Emirates
Standardized Test Achieve (EmSAT) 2024-2025**

Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce the launch of the Emirates Standardized Test –Achieve on its 9th cycle for the current Academic year 2024-2025.

EmSAT Achieve test for Grade 12 is mandatory the following categories:

- Emirati and non-Emirati students studying at the Continuing Education Centers - Home Study Track.
- Students who desire to complete their studies at a public or private university in the UAE.
- National service students and applicants to military colleges.

Registration Conditions for Achieve grade 12:

- While registering students of determination assure to select special needs field along with attaching official medical reports supporting their health condition.
- While registering students who do not hold an Emirates ID for any reason, their account is created through EmSAT website (Contact us page), then select application for non-Emirati ID holders/ Decree holders / special cases. Fill in the required data, including all required documents and information that clarify the reason for the not obtaining the ID or its non-renewal.
- EmSAT Achieve grade 12 is one of the university admission requirements for public/private universities and colleges in the UAE.
- EmSAT Achieve grade 12 is one of the main conditions when applying for scholarships through higher education institutions in the UAE.
- Students who are expected to apply for national service must ensure taking the test before their joining date.

EmSAT Achieve tests offer the following subjects for all targeted applicants:

- Arabic
- English
- Math
- Physics
- Chemistry
- Biology
- Computer Science

- ◆ EmSAT website contains all test samples, specifications, and performance levels.
- ◆ EmSAT website contains registration process, test rules and policies, test instructions, test calendar and a list of all authorized test center across the UAE.
- ◆ Students will have the opportunity to choose test dates, locations and timings as well as viewing all results on their Achieve – Student Portal.
- ◆ Its obligatory for students to thoroughly read list of terms and conditions available on the portal and they will be fully responsible if any is violated.
- ◆ Students may benefit from the pre-booking service and pay later in order to view the result (referring to payment table).
- ◆ Students now have the option to submit their absence excuses through their portal; once the excuse get accepted the paid amount will be credited to their accounts allowing them to re-book without paying.
