For convenience of parents and the school we would like to inform you that ADEK has partnered our school with the Department of Health to facilitate in-school PCR testing for all students who are attending the school physically. This will help the school to maintain the validity of the student PCR test. Kindly find below the update to the frequency of testing for unvaccinated and vaccinated students below the age of 12 years:

Category	First entry PCR testing	Routine PCR Testing	
		From 29 August – 27 September (First 30 days of school)	28 September onwards
unvaccinated and vaccinated students below the age of 12	96 hours validity	30 days validity	30 days validity

Please note the following points below:

- Fill in the PCR consent form through the link <https://forms.office.com/r/vDseuESnsW> if you are willing to get your child tested or not it is MANDATORY to fill through the link.
- Fill in the in-school PCR consent form which is attached with the circular (kindly print, fill and send the form along with your child) please note this is MANDATORY without the consent form the child will not be tested, kindly fill the forms by Monday 6th September 2021.
- Please provide the school with the copy of the student's Emirates ID (back and front) along with the filled consent forms by Monday 6th September 2021.
- PCR testing will be free of cost



- For any reason if your child will be absent, he/she can get the test done at any medical facilities by using the school code – 9131.
- PCR test will be conducted in the school on 7th September 2021, if you do not want your child to be test, kindly make your own arrangements and provide the school with the PCR test result by 8th September 2021, if you failed to provide the test result your child will not be allowed to attend the school.
