# break: to separate into pieces or tear apart



#### **Text Features**


Text features are parts of text that draw your attention to important information




## **Understanding Text Features**

#### **Heading**

A heading is the title at the top of a page or at the beginning of a new chapter or section.



The heading helps the reader know what that section is going to be about.
